III. GIFT STATEMENT AND VALUATION

1. **No Consideration:** The Donor hereby transfers ownership of the Vehicle to the Recipient as a bona fide gift. No purchase price, monetary consideration, or other valuable consideration has been paid, is owed, or will be received by the Donor from the Recipient in connection with this transfer.
2. **Declared Value:** The estimated fair market value of the Vehicle at the time of this transfer is \$_____. This valuation was determined in good faith by reference to the Kelley Blue Book or a similar valuation guide.
3. **Condition of Vehicle:** The Vehicle is transferred in "Good" condition.
4. **As-Is Transfer:** The Vehicle is transferred and sold "AS-IS" and "WHERE-IS" without any warranties, express or implied, including but not limited to any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. The Donor makes no representations regarding the mechanical condition, safety, or roadworthiness of the Vehicle.

IV. ODOMETER DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

Federal law (and applicable state laws, including but not limited to California Vehicle Code Section 5900,

Texas Transportation Code Section 501.072, and New York Vehicle and Traffic Law Section 329) requires that the transferor of a motor vehicle disclose the mileage upon transfer of ownership. Failure to complete this disclosure or providing false statements may result in fines and/or imprisonment.

2. **License Plates:** The license plates currently registered to the Vehicle shall remain with the Vehicle upon transfer, provided that such retention is permitted under the laws and regulations of the state of registration.

3. **Donor Deliverables:** The Donor shall deliver to the Recipient at the time of transfer the Certificate of Title, a signed title assignment, this completed Odometer Disclosure Statement, and a Lien Release confirming that the Vehicle is free and clear of all liens and encumbrances.

4. **Lien Status:** The Donor certifies and warrants that the Vehicle is free and clear of all liens, loans, security interests, or encumbrances of any kind.
