This Agreement shall remain in effect until the child(ren) reach the age of majority, unless otherwise terminated by mutual written consent of the parties.

11. DEFAULT AND REMEDY PROVISIONS

In the event of a breach of this Agreement, the non-breaching party shall be entitled to seek all available legal and equitable remedies, including but not limited to specific performance and damages.
