D. Special Days and Holidays:

3. **Child's Birthday:** The child(ren)'s birthday, if it falls within the Summer Period, shall be spent with Parent _____ in even-numbered years and Parent _____ in odd-numbered years. The other Parent shall have a reasonable opportunity for a phone call or video chat with the child(ren) on their birthday.
4. **Other Holidays:** Any other holidays falling within a Parent's scheduled visitation block shall be spent with that Parent.

V. EXCHANGE PROTOCOL

A. **Exchange Location:** All exchanges of the child(ren) shall occur at:
or as otherwise mutually agreed upon by the Parents in writing.

B. **Exchange Time:** Exchanges shall occur at the times specified in Section IV, unless otherwise mutually agreed upon by the Parents in writing.

C. Transportation Responsibility:

- Parent 1 shall be responsible for transportation at the commencement of Parent 2's visitation blocks and Parent 2 shall be responsible for transportation at the conclusion of Parent 2's visitation blocks.
- Parent 2 shall be responsible for transportation at the commencement of Parent 1's visitation blocks and Parent 1 shall be responsible for transportation at the conclusion of Parent 1's visitation blocks.
- Parents shall alternate transportation responsibilities, with Parent 1 responsible for the first exchange of the summer and alternating thereafter.
- Other: _____

D. **Punctuality:** Both Parents agree to be punctual for all exchanges. In the event of an unavoidable delay, the delaying Parent shall notify the other Parent as soon as reasonably possible. A delay of more than _____ minutes without prior notification may result in the forfeiture of that exchange period, at the discretion of the non-delaying Parent.

VI. COMMUNICATION

A. Parent-Child Communication: Each Parent shall permit reasonable and unhindered telephone, video, or electronic communication between the child(ren) and the other Parent during their respective visitation periods. Such communication shall not interfere with the child(ren)'s sleep, school, or scheduled activities.

B. Parent-Parent Communication: Parents agree to communicate respectfully and cooperatively regarding the child(ren)'s well-being, health, education, and any changes to the schedule. All communication regarding the child(ren) shall be conducted in a civil and constructive manner.

VII. MEDICAL AND EMERGENCY CARE

Each Parent shall be authorized to make emergency medical decisions for the child(ren) during their respective visitation periods. In the event of a medical emergency, the Parent with the child(ren) shall immediately notify the other Parent and provide details of the emergency and the care being provided. Non-emergency medical care shall be discussed and agreed upon by both Parents, if feasible, or handled in accordance with the underlying custody order.

VIII. TRAVEL

A. Domestic Travel: Each Parent may travel with the child(ren) within the United States during their scheduled visitation blocks without prior consent from the other Parent, provided they notify the other Parent of the itinerary, including destination, dates, and contact information, at least _____ days in advance of departure.

B. International Travel: International travel with the child(ren) by either Parent requires the express written consent of the other Parent, unless otherwise provided in the underlying custody order.

IX. MODIFICATIONS

Any modifications to this Summer Child Visitation Schedule must be made in writing and signed by both Parents. Verbal agreements to modify this Schedule are not binding.

X. ACKNOWLEDGMENT

The Parents acknowledge that this Schedule is intended to supplement and clarify the existing custody

order or agreement for the Summer Period and does not modify any other terms of the underlying order or agreement. Both Parents agree to abide by the terms set forth herein in good faith and in the best interests of the child(ren).
