II. CHILD(REN)

III. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Agreement is to establish a clear, consistent, and predictable alternating weekly custody schedule for the minor child(ren) identified above, ensuring clarity and consistency in co-parenting arrangements between the Parents. This Agreement is intended to promote the best interests of the child(ren) by providing a stable and regular routine.

IV. ALTERNATING WEEKLY CUSTODY SCHEDULE

The Parents hereby agree to an alternating weekly custody schedule for the child(ren) as follows: A.

Commencement of Schedule: The alternating weekly schedule shall commence on the _____ day of _____, 20_____.

B. Alternating Weeks:

1. **Parent 1's Week:** Parent 1 shall have physical custody of the child(ren) beginning on Friday at 5:00 PM and continuing until the following Friday at 5:00 PM.

2. **Parent 2's Week:** Parent 2 shall have physical custody of the child(ren) beginning on the Friday immediately following Parent 1's week at 5:00 PM and continuing until the subsequent Friday at 5:00 PM.

3. The Parents shall continue to alternate weeks in this manner, with exchanges occurring every Friday at 5:00 PM.

V. EXCHANGE LOGISTICS

A. Exchange Location: The exchange of the child(ren) shall occur at:

(e.g., a neutral public location, the child(ren)'s school, or one of the Parents' residences).

B. Transportation: The Parent whose week is commencing shall be responsible for picking up the child(ren) at the designated exchange location. The Parent whose week is ending shall be responsible for dropping off the child(ren) at the designated exchange location. Both Parents shall ensure the child(ren) are ready for exchange at the agreed-upon time.

VI. HOLIDAYS AND SPECIAL OCCASIONS

Specific arrangements for holidays, school breaks, birthdays, and other special occasions shall be determined by mutual agreement of the Parents or as outlined in a separate, more comprehensive parenting plan or court order. In the absence of such an agreement or order, the alternating weekly schedule shall continue to apply.

VII. COMMUNICATION

A. Parent-to-Parent Communication: Parents shall communicate respectfully and directly regarding the child(ren)'s welfare, education, and health. All communication shall be conducted in a timely manner and focused on the best interests of the child(ren).

B. Parent-to-Child Communication: Each Parent shall allow the child(ren) reasonable telephone, video, and electronic communication with the other Parent during their respective custody periods. Such communication should not interfere with the child(ren)'s school, extracurricular activities, or sleep.

VIII. MEDICAL AND EDUCATIONAL DECISIONS

Unless otherwise specified in a court order, Parents shall jointly make all major decisions concerning the child(ren)'s health, education, and welfare. Each Parent shall keep the other informed of any significant medical appointments, school events, or other important matters affecting the child(ren).

IX. MODIFICATION

This Agreement may be modified only by a written instrument signed by both Parents. Any modification must be in the best interests of the child(ren).

X. GOVERNING LAW AND COURT ORDERS

This Agreement is subject to any existing or future orders of a court of competent jurisdiction concerning the custody and visitation of the child(ren). In the event of a conflict between this Agreement and a court order, the court order shall prevail.

XI. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Parents regarding the alternating weekly custody schedule and supersedes all prior discussions, negotiations, and agreements, whether oral or written, concerning the subject matter hereof.
